DREAMER TRUST is a government approved non-profit social service organisation. In India, women and children living below the poverty line work for food, education and self-reliance. DREAMER TRUST truly believes that anyone can change society and the environment. In this organisation many hardworking volunteers are working day and night to make our dreams come true with their talents.

DREAMER TRUST has so far received no government / corporate / foreign funding and continued support. It depends entirely on donations and generous minded people. We are a non-governmental organisation (NGO) registered to work on an all-India basis. Our main goal is to provide food, education, self-reliant development and happy life for children and women. FOOD BASKET FOR HUNGER

'DREAMER TRUST' has reached out to slum dwellers, remote villages and street dwellers, just to those who can't afford to feed themselves. " DREAMER TRUST " provides food to those who live on the streets, homeless, mentally / physically disabled, brick kiln workers, the needy and the elderly.

We distribute basic cooking ingredients such as rice, pulses, potatoes, soybean pieces, eggs, fish, meat, etc. to those who are unable to cook their own food and live on the sidewalk or under any bridge.



We provide regular nutritious food to keep our children healthy and fit. We regularly run this project called Food Basket for Hunger. 'DREAMER TRUST' continues to distribute cooked food in different parts of West Bengal so that no child suffers from hunger pangs. We have tried to fill the nutritional gap of their food and serve them quality food. This effort of the organisation is being conducted in the public interest community. Free "food baskets" are provided to every needy and hungry person in the society irrespective of race, religion and caste.

CLOTH DONATION DRIVE

'DREAMER TRUST' collects new and unused clothing and distributes it to the poor who cannot afford it. It also provides new clothes to entertain the children and street children before the Durga Puja and winter clothes to protect them from the cold.

The Dreamer Trust team goes door-to-door to collect new and unused clothing, then check and sort the wearable clothes, make them usable and then distribute.



Distribution of new garments before Durga Puja: We have distributed all kinds of new garments to many needy people (especially children) in the brick fields, sidewalks and slums of Kolkata and surrounding areas before Durga Puja.

Distribution of winter clothes including shawls, blankets, sweaters, mufflers etc. for the needy people in different parts of West Bengal during the winter season.

RATION KIT DISTRIBUTION

The second wave of coronavirus epidemic in India has once again devastated the daily wage earners. The deadly COVID-19 lockdown in March 2020 left many families jobless with no income. With trade closed and shops closed, daily wages, van drivers and vegetable sellers are struggling to survive and meet the end of this lockdown period. They are worried about their families and children. DREAMER TRUST has taken initiative to provide dry ration kits to these families.



'Dreamer Trust' has tried its best to stay in various slums, railway stations, street children and remote villages of West Bengal with dry food several times so that they do not suffer from food shortage.

Dreamer Trust has been distributing Ration Kit every month to the helpless and poor families who have no one to earn, who are completely unable to earn.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

'Dreamer Trust' celebrates special days like Holi, Diwali, Eid, Durga Puja and New Year with the deprived and neglected children of the society. We organise games competitions for children. We encourage the first, second and third place winners. These festivals not only describe the diversity of the nation, but also the unity and fragrance of being different from others. We have imparted knowledge among groups that cultural awareness is about recognising and understanding the different values shaped by our different cultural backgrounds. So, we should respect the different cultures that exist in our country. By being respectful of others and accepting people's opinions, rights and feelings - we allow ourselves to build more successful personal and professional relationships and benefit from cultural diversity. Being culturally aware and sensitive to cultural differences can become an essential skill in our daily work life.



EMERGENCY & RELIEF

The 'DREAMER TRUST' volunteers are fully prepared to respond quickly and effectively to disasters such as Covid 19 and Yash cyclones and other disasters. We focus on meeting basic humanitarian needs immediately by providing food and relief services. We also provide assistance to disaster-affected individuals and families to enable them to resume their normal daily activities independently. Volunteers joined in to provide massive relief during the Bengal famine, Cyclone Medinipur.

Covid-19 Relief Work:

During the Covid-19 epidemic, we provided food to the needy people of various areas including Michael Nagar, Madhyamgram Nutan Palli, Rickshaw Colony, Chandigarh, Aminpur Falti Para, Magri Village Governance, Dattapukur, Abdalpur and other areas of West Bengal.

YASH Cyclone Relief Work:

In the year 2021-2022, 500 families in Digha, West Bengal and 500 families in Mandarmani received dry food, drinking water, raw food and baby food during the Covid-19 epidemic and the destruction of Super Cyclone Yash.
